Dr. Kuang S. Yeh is a professor of Organization Management at National Sun Yat-Sen University in Kaohsiung, Taiwan. Between May 20, 2008 and January 13, 2015, Prof. Yeh had served in the government as the Deputy Minister of Research, Development and Evaluation Commission, Deputy Minister of Transportation and Communications and Minister of Transportation and Communications. During his term as the Deputy Minister of Transportation and Communications, he also served as the founding Chairman of Taoyuan Airport Corporation.

Professor Yeh is the author of eight well-recognized general management text books (in Chinese) and more than 50 academic articles. Prior to joining National Sun Yat-Sen University in 1991, he held an appointment as Visiting Assistant Professor at State University of New York at Stony Brook. Before being a government official, Professor Yeh was a columnist for leading business journals in Taiwan such as, *Commonwealth Magazine*, *Economic Daily News, and Commercial Times*.
